

**Class Policies** – Most classes require a minimum of three people per class. If it appears that there will not be enough participants after you have registered we will notify you and give you a refund. **All classes must be paid for in advance.** Refunds will be given only until the week before class, although you may send someone in your place after this. Unless otherwise stated, please do not bring children to classes. **All class participants receive 10% off their purchases during class time (excluding consignment items.)**
